

Ek Bharat Shreshth Bharat (EBSB) Club



EBSB (Ek Bharat Shreshth Bharat) is a program which promotes national integration through systematic exchange between the paired institutions in various fields such as cultural, literary and linguistics. The idea of a sustained and structured

cultural connect between denizens of different regions was mooted by Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi during the Rashtriya Ekta Divas held on 31stOctober, 2015 to commemorate the birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel. Under EBSB each state and UT of India is paired with another to promote the spirit of national integration amongst that states and respective colleges concerned. The state of Haryana is paired with the state of Telangana; Sh. L. N. Hindu College is paired with Government Degree College, Gajewal, Telangana.

1.Two-Day Online Workshop





2. National Unity Day Celebration






5.Online Session for Learning Sentences in Telugu Language
