# **Course Objectives:**

## To help students to understand and learn the following basic techniques of First Aid:

- To provide a step by step guide how to deal with various emergency situations like; heart attacks, choking, head injuries, poisoning and road traffic accident victims.
- How to administer immediate medical attention to someone who has suffered from injuries
- How to prevent minor injuries from becoming major ones
- How to deal with everyday minor accidents
- To treat an unconscious and breathing casualty.
- Learn the treatment for minor cuts, grazes, bleeding and burns.
- How to use the contents of a First Aid Kit.
- Avoid cross infection.
- How to treat someone who is choking.
- Learn how to relax someone who is in shock.
- Deal with burns and scalds.

- Students will be able to understand the responsibilities of an Occupational First Aider.
- How to help and protect the community, friends, family and colleagues.
