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


Evaluation of Students' Satisfaction Survey For the session 2022-23

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1) Are you satisfied with the present curriculum prescribed by the college?




Observation:

• 86.5% of students gave their responses in Yes while 13.5% students gave their responses is No.

Action Taken:

2) Do you think teachers get adequate time to complete the syllabus?




• 88.6% of students gave their responses in Yes while 11.4% students gave their responses in No.

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3) How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?




Observation:

Observation:


• 34.7% students gave their responses that teachers are thoroughly prepared for the classes while 53.7% students responded that teachers are satisfactorily prepared for classes.

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5) The teachers illustrates the concepts through examples and applications.




Observation:

6) Teachers inform you about importance, career prospects, course outcomes of the subjects being taught:




Observation:

• 51.4% of the students responded that teachers every time inform the students about the importance of subject being taught.


Action Taken:

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7) How well are the teachers able to communicate?




Observation:

Observation:


• 50 % of students, teachers use ICT tools.

• Faculty was asked to conduct move more student centric methods based activities to make teaching-learning more effective.


10) Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them?

• 49% of the students responded that teachers are every time able to identify students weakness and help them to overcome that.


Action Taken:

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11) How often do you interact with your subject teacher inside or outside classroom?




Observation:


Action Taken:

Observation:


• 42.3% of the students strongly agreed that our institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow while 31.7% of the students agreed for the same.

Extra curricular activities.




Observation:

17) The overall quality of teaching-learning process in the institute is very good.




Observation:

18) What is your opinion about the library materials for the course?




Observation:

19) The seminars ,workshops,research activities,other Co-Curricular and Extra curricular activities of the college are value addition in the curriculum.




• 33.2% of the students strongly agreed for the same while 44.2% of the students agreed in this regard.

- New MOUs should be signed from the concerned authorities.


20) Have you taken part in any seminars, workshop or other Co-Curricular and extracurricular activities of the college?

21)Efforts are made by institute/teachers to inculcate soft skills.life skills And employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.




 Almost 50 % of the students are agreed that institute make efforts to agreed extent in this regard.

22)You have used the sports facility in the college.




Observation:
