About The College:

Sh. L.N. Hindu College,Rohtak previously known as Hindu College, was founded in 1971 by the Hindu Education Society (Regd.), Rohtak, for providing value-based education to the growing number of students. To accommodate more and more students, the Hindu Education Society purchased 13 acres of land on Bhiwani Road, Rohtak, on which the foundation stone of the new building was laid by 1008 Swami GurucharanDass Ji Maharaj in 1974. Subsequently, the heirs of Shri Lal Nath donated 250 Acres of agricultural land to the society. Hence, the college was renamed as Sh. L. N. Hindu College,Rohtak. The college has now carved out its special place on the Educational Map of Haryana. It enjoys the reputation of being the premier institution imparting the quality education in Arts, Commerce, Science, Management, and Information Technology.

- 5. Providing internships and other practical learning opportunities to students.

Responsibilities:

The Parties agree to the following responsibilities:

- 1. The College shall provide Kala Parishad with a suitable venue for cultural events.
- 2. The College shall offer necessary facilities and support during the course of cultural events.
- Kala Parishad shall bear all the expenses related to cultural events.
- Kala Parishad shall provide opportunities for the students of the College to participate in the cultural
 events and other activities organized by Kala Parishad.
- Kala Parishad shall ensure that all the cultural events and other activities are conducted in a professional and well-organized manner.

Term:

This MOU shall come into effect immediately upon signing by both parties and shall remain in force for a period of three years, unless terminated earlier by mutual consent.

Amendments:

Any amendments or modifications to this MOU shall be made in writing and signed by both parties.

Termination:

Either party may terminate this MOU by providing thirty days' written notice to the other party.

This MOU shall be governed and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Haryana.



- Termination: Either party may terminate this MoU by providing a written notice of termination at least60 days in advance. Termination shall not affect any ongoing projects or initiatives unless mutually agreed upon in writing.

This MoU represents the understanding and intentions of the College & the Organization hence, serves as a basis for cooperation and collaboration. Both parties agree to work in good faith and actively pursue the objectives.



Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made between Sh. L.N Hindu College Bhiwani Road, Rohtak (Haryana) and Rotary Club Rohtak.

Objectives: The objectives of this collaboration are as follows:

- 1. To promote vocational education and skill development among the students.
- To enhance the employability of the students by providing them with hands-on training and practical exposure.
- 3. To foster entrepreneurship and encourage self-employment opportunities.
- To facilitate the exchange of knowledge and resources between College, Rotary Club Rohtak.

Terms and Conditions:

 Duration: This MoU dated August 29, 2020 shall be valid for a period of three years till August 28, 2023.

· Responsibilities of College

- a) The College shall incorporate vocational training courses related to sewing and garment making in its curriculum.
- b) The College shall designate a faculty member as the coordinator for the collaboration.
- c) The College shall provide necessary infrastructure and facilities for the vocational training courses, including sewing machines and equipments.
- d) The College shall ensure the participation of interested students in the Training Programs organized by Rotary Club, Rohtak.

• Responsibilities of Rotary Club Rohtak:

- a) Rotary Club Rohtak shall organize Vocational Training Programs for the students.
- Rotary Club, Rohtak shall provide expert trainers and instructors for the vocational training programs.

- c) Rotary Club, Rohtak shall facilitate the placement of eligible students in internships and job opportunities related to sewing and garment making.
