

The awareness of basic legal education and rules must be a part of academic institutes. With this aim "National Legal Literacy Mission" was introduced on 6th March 2005 with its motto, "From Ignorance to Legal Empowerment". Youth play a vital role in society; they can spread the awareness of rights and duties among their surroundings. If youth is well aware about their rights and duties then they can give the right direction to entire society. It will also be very helpful to empower the most marginalized, vulnerable, poor, disadvantaged, underprivileged persons of the society particularly women, children and disabled person. There are mainly three piler of this mission i.e. legal rights, education on fundamental duties and education on the availability and benefits of legal aid. Keeping this in view, Haryana State Legal Services Authority (HALSA) has adopted the project in collaboration with Higher Education Department of Haryana. As a result, The Legal Literacy Cell was established in Government & Government Aided Colleges in the session 2008-2009 with a view to make the students legally literate and create a generation for future which is well aware about its constitutional & statutory rights and duties.

Aims and Objectives:

- 1. The Legal Literacy Cell frame basic legal knowledge among youth and educates them about common right, duties, benefits and laws.
- 2. The Legal Literacy Cell endeavour to foam awareness in young female about their constitutional legal rights & duties. It strengthens them to fight gender discrimination, domestic violence, sexual harassment, dowry and injustice in social life.
- **3.** The Legal Literacy Cell aim is to Empower Individuals and makes them active about the law. For this purposes cell organizes Lectures through legal experts, law officers and eminent lawyers on important everyday legal issues, laws, rules and Regulations.
- **4.** The Legal Literacy Cell aim is to aware students about the free legal services provided by various agencies.
- **5.** Some common acts are very important for society, keeping this in view cell is provides basic information about Anti Ragging Act, Domestic Violence Act 2005, PCPNDT Act1994, Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961etc.
- **6.** The basic awareness regarding Traffic rules Health & Hygiene, Road Safety, Environment, Right to Information, Right of destitute of women and children, Right of senior citizens, Right to education are also provided by the Cell.

The National Legal Literacy mission will succeed if each citizen participates with enthusiasm and it becomes people's movement. Haryana state could be the torch bearer to the whole nation in this legal literacy mission, if we are successful in the way we have planned.
